

Day Fee

The day fee includes tuition, lunches, most extra-curricular activities, basic stationery and teaching materials (textbooks on short-term loan). The fees do not include examination fees, some school trips, specialist tuition and out of school care for Junior School students.

Boarding Fee

The boarding fee includes all of the above plus full board, laundry and healthcare. The weekly boarding fee for UK students includes 5 nights board. There is some flexibility on which nights you can choose, but excludes board on a Saturday.

Summary of Fee Arrangements (Full terms and conditions available on request)

Fees are payable one month in advance of the first day of each term. A full term's notice in writing or a term's payment in lieu is required before removal of a student other than at the end of the upper sixth form year. No reduction in fees can be made for absence due to illness; however insurance is available for parents who wish to protect themselves against this eventuality.

In accepting a place at the school, the parent or guardian accepts responsibility for the payment of school fees (less bursary or other assistance) for the entire period during which the student remains at the school, unless this responsibility is accepted by another party in writing. Interest is charged on overdue fees. There are financial benefits to parents who pay their school fees in advance; details are available on request to the Finance Department.

Deposit

When a student is accepted in the school, a refundable deposit is payable. This deposit is **in addition** to the normal termly fee and is due on acceptance of a place offered. The deposit is refunded when the student finally leaves the school, once all fees and extras have been settled.

Registration Fee

To be considered for a place at Sidcot, a non refundable registration fee of £150 (£75 Sidcot Junior School) is payable to cover the administration costs of the application. If a student has special educational needs that the school has to consider before offering a place, a non refundable fee of £50 is payable to cover the consultation and referral costs. If the school is able to meet the needs of the student, then a further £100 is payable with the application form. All students who wish to apply for a bursary need to make a formal application to the school including the non refundable registration fee and follow the school's admissions procedure before we can consider their bursary enquiry.
