



Day Fee

The day fee includes tuition, most extra-curricular activities, stationery, teaching materials (textbooks on short-term loan) and £100 per term for lunches. The fees do not include examination fees, some school trips and specialist tuition. There is the option of an evening meal in school if prep and activities are done after the end of the teaching day, this is also included in the day fee.

Boarding Fee

The boarding fee includes all the above plus full board, laundry and healthcare. Weekly boarding and flexi boarding may also be possible, subject to availability. The weekly boarding fee for UK pupils excludes board on Fridays and Saturdays.

Summary of Fee Arrangements

(Full terms and conditions available on request)

Fees for EU and Overseas students are payable one month in advance of the first day of each term. Fees for UK students are payable by the first day of each term. A full term's notice in writing or a term's payment in lieu is required before removal of a pupil other than at the end of the upper sixth form year. No reduction in fees can be made for absence due to illness; however insurance is available for parents who wish to protect themselves against this eventuality.

In accepting a place in the school, the parent or guardian accepts responsibility for the payment of school fees (less bursary or other assistance) for the entire period during which the pupil remains at the school, unless this responsibility is accepted by another party in writing. Interest is charged on overdue fees. There can be financial benefits to parents who pay their entire school fees in advance; details are available on request.

Guardians

It is a condition of entry that all pupils from overseas have a mature and responsible UK guardian. This may be a friend or relative in the UK over the age of 25 or a specialist guardian agency which will charge appropriate fees

Registration Fee

At the time of registration at the school, a fee of £150 (£75 Sidcot Junior School) is payable to cover administration costs. The fee is not refundable.

Disbursement Deposits

When a pupil is accepted in the school, a refundable disbursement deposit is payable. This deposit is in addition to the normal termly fee. Both the deposit and the first term's fee are due on acceptance of a place offered. The disbursement deposit is refundable when the pupil finally leaves the school, once all fees and extras have been settled.

Specialist Tuition

Sidcot School offers specialist tuition in a wide range of subjects and activities including Music, Drama, Dance, Swimming, Fencing, Horse Riding and in Supplementary Education for those with specific learning needs. If you would like or need specialist tuition please see the relevant Department Head to organise and book the lessons for the following term.

Charges

for Music, EFL, Supplementary Education* and Drama Lessons

EFL (English as a Foreign Language), Music, Drama and Supplementary Education charges are payable in advance as part of the termly fees invoice. The annual charge is for 30 lessons delivered over the year – normally 12 in the Autumn Term, 10 in the Spring Term and 8 in the Summer Term and is payable in three equal instalments at the beginning of each term.

Parents are advised that best efforts will be made to ensure that their child receives 30 lessons during the course of each academic year. Lessons missed through school trips will, wherever possible be rescheduled however, lessons missed with no notification to the relevant member of staff or due to pupil sickness or non receipt of payment will not be rescheduled.

Lessons will not begin until payment of the term's instalment has been received. A full term's notice of cessation is required.
