<u>General</u>	
Hair	Long hair must be tied back off the face at all times and hair nets must be worn when representing Sidcot School.
Jewellery	Jewellery should not be worn.
Naming	All equestrian clothing, boots and equipment must be clearly labelled.

All items are compulsory unless marked optional.

Every rider should have the following riding kit:

- Dark or beige jodhpurs
- Sidcot PE shirt
- Sidcot baselayer top
- Riding boots long or short with Gaiters or chaps
- Riding gloves
- Hair net for girls (long hair must be tied back)
- Full set of waterproofs
- Riding hat which must meet UK standard PAS015 or SNELL 2001
- Back protector standard which must be Beta purple label 2009
- For those wishing to compete a show jacket and white jodhpurs

For any student bringing a horse to Sidcot, please ensure the following items are labelled:

- Horse passport
- Bridle (bits as required)
- Fitted saddle
- Girth
- Saddle cloths
- Exercise boots
- Stable rugs (light weight, medium and heavy weight)
- 2 x coolers
- Turn out rugs (lightweight, medium weight, heavy weight)
- Grooming kit
- Head collar and lead rope
- A detailed list of your horse's current feed, supplements and stable vices if appropriate.
