Arrangements for Key Workers


Thank you for contacting us to identify yourself as a Key Worker. Now that we have heard from the Department for Education and Cabinet Office, we wish to confirm with you that the government guidance states that you should only bring your child to be looked after in school if it is absolutely necessary. This is to keep your child safe and limit the spread of infection.

With this in mind, please can you confirm that it is absolutely necessary for your child to be brought into School? This means that if there is a possibility that someone else is able to take care of them, we would not expect them to be brought in to Key Worker care.

We trust you understand that we are doing all we can to minimise the risk of contamination in school. This resource is finite and we have to be absolutely sure that you fully qualify for the provision.

I would be grateful if you could confirm your need by the end of the school day at 4.30pm.
