## Whole School Information

- 1. SchoolsBuddy After School Options It has come to our attention that not all students are using SchoolsBuddy on a daily basis to inform the school of what they are doing after school. It is of paramount importance that we know where all our students are for safeguarding, health and safety reasons. We would therefore like to remind all students that they must log in to SchoolsBuddy and select an option for every day of the week, including the going home option if that is applicable. Your child's tutor will be monitoring this, ensuring that all students are signing up as requested. Students are able to cancel an option and reselect if required to accommodate any change in plans throughout the week. We will be reminding students how to use SchoolsBuddy on the first Monday back and will have a help desk in the hub at lunchtimes during the first week after half term run by our Office Holder team. Thank you for your support with this matter.
- 2. As usual the library has been busy this term issuing books. Some books borrowed in the early weeks of term (and in some cases before the summer holiday) are now overdue and are yet to come back. The pupils have been reminded by tutors and library staff. Please check with your children and encourage them to look for any library books over the holiday.
- 3. Swim Academy & Club members As we are a Swim England affiliated club all Academy & Club swimmers are required to be registered with Swim England after they have attended three sessions. We will be completing the membership registrations this week. As we are unable to run Academy & Club in the normal manner due to Covid restrictions we will not be passing on the cost of this term's affiliation fees. Despite being an outdoor event, we are mindful of the risk of bringing so many people together when there are still numerous COVID cases in the local community. We apologise for any upset this may cause, but believe it to be a prudent decision at this time.
