Whole School Information

- Please find attached a letter from Sirona care & health regarding the rollout of the second dose of Covid vaccinations which will take place in school on Friday 4th February. This is for students currently aged 12-15. The vaccination programme is carried out by Sirona, rather than the School, and we are able to assist in providing the facilities for them to do so. Please read the letter carefully to establish whether your child is currently able to access their second vaccination. If you would like them to receive their first dose, that is also possible. In the letter you will find a link to the consent form which Sirona must receive in order for the vaccination, first or second, to go ahead. Their deadline for receiving consent forms is Tuesday 1st February.
- 2. Exam Invigilators Sidcot School is currently recruiting exam invigilators. This is a casual post, with much of the work taking place during school hours and therefore can suit parents. It is perfectly possible to be an invigilator in your own child's school and your increased knowledge of the exam process will help you to support your own child when they sit exams. 3. Face Coverings - From 20 January, face coverings are no longer required for students, staff or visitors in classrooms. However, the wearing of a face-covering remains a personal choice. Face coverings for students, staff, and visitors are still required in communal areas.

From 27 January, face coverings will no longer be required to be worn by anyone when in school. However, the wearing of a face-covering remains a personal choice.

The School will continue to monitor the number of COVID-cases and work with the UK Health Security Agency. We will adapt the Schools procedures to manage COVID-19 as required.
