4 sets Home clothes (machine washable) must include 1 smart set (Set includes: socks/tights, trousers/skirts/dress, tops/blouses, jumper/cardigan)

Notes to Parents of Boarding Girls

Hair Hair should be neat, clean, and of a natural colour. Long hair

should be tidy and tied back off the face. In terms of colour only

natural highlights are permitted.

Home clothes Please do not send more since storage is limited.

Make-up Make-up should not be obvious. Nail varnish of any sort is not

acceptable below Sixth Form.

Jewellery Jewellery should not be worn with uniform. Students with

pierced lobes may wear retainer studs, up to one in each ear: two in total. Two or more earrings in one ear is not acceptable. Other piercings, including nose studs, are not acceptable. One single neck chain may be worn discretely under the uniform. Naming All clothing, shoes, boots and equipment must be clearly

marked.

Personal Possessions Valuable items should not be brought to school as the school

cannot be held responsible in cases of loss or damage. Please ensure that all personal possessions are clearly marked to help
